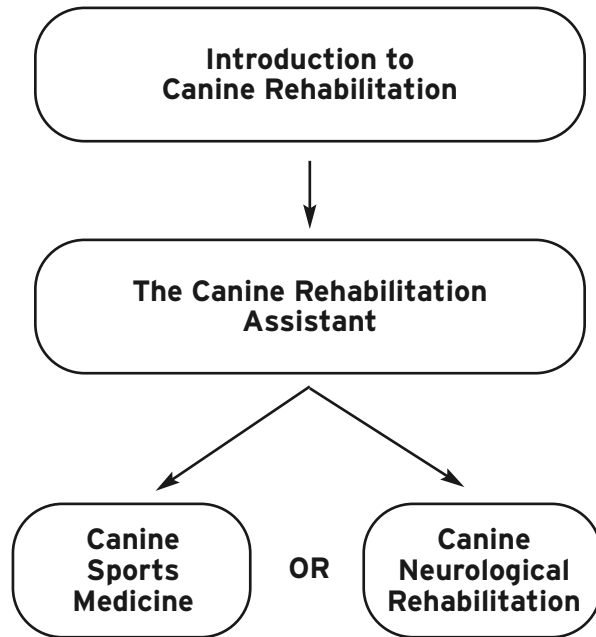

# Certified Canine Rehabilitation Assistant

CRI instructors are leaders in their fields. Our classes are small, and learning is hands-on with dogs on site providing real-life lessons. And all of our certification programs are AAVSB R.A.C.E. approved.

The Canine Rehabilitation Assistant (CCRA) program is for Veterinary Technicians and Physical Therapist Assistants. The curriculum includes three courses: Introduction to Canine Rehabilitation, The Canine Rehabilitation Assistant, and one elective. Final exams are open-book and take-home with collaboration encouraged. A final project involving outcome measurement is required.

Courses are offered in Florida from November through April and in Colorado from May through October.



## Introduction to Canine Rehabilitation (6 days)

This course provides students with a fundamental understanding of canine anatomy, physiology and biomechanics. Students build relevant structures on canine skeletons using clay, and get hands-on practice palpating dogs in the classroom. Common orthopedic and neurological disorders are covered including both conservative and surgical treatment options. Canine rehabilitation modalities including traditional physical therapy and integrative therapies are introduced, as well as ways they can be incorporated into a veterinary practice.

Topics Covered Include:

- Comparative anatomy and biomechanics (human and canine)
- The physiology, kinesiology, and biomechanics of joints and muscles
- Manual therapy, therapeutic exercise and aquatic therapy
- LASER, ultrasound, thermal agents and electrotherapy
- Integrative therapies including acupuncture, chiropractics and homeopathy
- Patient assessment, treatment planning and outcome measurement
- Infectious diseases and zoonoses
- The business of canine rehabilitation

## The Canine Rehabilitation Assistant (6 days)

This course covers functional canine anatomy, therapeutic modalities, therapeutic exercise, hydrotherapy and massage. The basics of neurological rehabilitation are introduced. Outcome measurement, documentation, and client education are also discussed.

Topics Covered Include:

- Muscles and muscle groups as they apply to canine function and rehabilitation
- Assisting in basic canine orthopedic and neurological evaluations
- LASER, ultrasound, thermal agents and electrotherapy
- Implementing therapeutic exercise programs
- Hydrotherapy and massage
- Rehabilitation-specific documentation
- Client education
- Maintenance of therapeutic modalities and hydrotherapy equipment

## ELECTIVES

### Canine Sports Medicine (3 days)

This course covers canine anatomy and locomotion and how they relate to performance. Sports injuries in canine athletes are covered including their causes, prevention and rehabilitation. Participants are introduced to canine sporting events and the organizations that oversee them.

### Canine Neurological Rehabilitation (3 days)

This course covers the basics of canine neuroanatomy and neurophysiology and their application to physical therapy and rehabilitation. Students learn how to perform a neurological exam and apply neurophysiological facilitation techniques. Setting treatment goals and measuring outcomes are also discussed.
